

## Homo Urbanus

In ihrer filmischen Serie „Homo Urbanus“ richten Louise Lemoine und Ila Bêka ihren Blick auf die Relationen zwischen urbanem Raum und deren Bewohner: innen. Anhand detaillierter Beobachtungen richten sie den Blick auf vielfältige urbane Formen und komplexe Interaktionen und Praktiken, die täglich zwischen Menschen und ihrer urbanen Umgebung entstehen.

„Now we work more on the scale of cities and are less linked to architecture specifically. We're much more into anthropological questions, such as: what is the homo urbanus (which means the 'urban human')? We try to understand how much human beings are modelled and completely transformed by the place they live in and how the culture, the economic and sociological elements of a city has an impact on the way we live in cities. And so we've moved a little bit from one interest to another, but it's still linked to the built and human environment.“ Louise Lemoine
